INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

Education Act 2002 - School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012 as amended by the School Governance (Constitution and Federations) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2014

1. The name of the federation is **The Trinity Federation**.
2. The names and categories of the schools in the federation are:

Name	Category
St Mary's Bluecoat Church of England (Aided) Primary School	Aided
Worfield Endowed Church of England Primary School	Aided
Beckbury Church of England (Controlled) Primary School	Voluntary Controlled

3. The name of the governing body is **the Governing Body of The Trinity Federation**.
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) **2 Parent Governors;**
 - (b) **1 Local Authority Nominated Governor;**
 - (c) **1 Staff Governor;**
 - (d) **1 Executive Headteacher;**
 - (e) **7 Foundation Governors**
5. Total number of governors shall be **12**.

8. **4** Foundation Governors shall be appointed as follows:-
 - (a) **3** are to be appointed by the Hereford Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with **The Parochial Parish Council of Bridgnorth and The Parochial Parish Council of Worfield**
 - (b) **1** is to be appointed by the Lichfield Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with **The Parochial Parish Council of Beckbury**

9. (a) The holder of the following office shall be Foundation Governor ex officio:
The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Bridgnorth
- (b) **The Archdeacon of Ludlow** shall be entitled to appoint foundation governors to act in place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or the ex officio governor has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
- c) The holder of the following office shall be Foundation Governor ex officio:
The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Worfield
- d) **The Archdeacon of Ludlow** shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (c) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or the ex officio governor has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
- e) The holder of the following office shall be Foundation Governor ex officio:
The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Beckbury
- f) **The Archdeacon of Salop** shall be entitled to appoint foundation governors to act in place of the ex officio foundation governors whose governorship derives from the office named in (e) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governors are unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governors, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which the governorship exists, or the ex officio governors have been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
10. **The Archdeacon of Ludlow** is entitled to request the removal of the ex officio foundation governors named in 9(a and c) and to appoint any substitute governors as provided by 9(b and d).

The Archdeacon of Salop is entitled to request the removal of the ex officio foundation governor named in 9(e) and to appoint a substitute governor as provided by 9(f).

12. **Ethos Statement**
