## FREE SCHOOL MEALS APPLICATIONS

Please read the attached letter relating to Free School Meals applications. If you believe your child may be eligible for Free School Meals we would encourage you to apply, even if your child is in Key Stage 1 and already receives Universal Infant Free School Meals. The many benefits of doing so are outlined in the letter. Please also note that free milk cannot be provided to pupils aged 5 and over, unless a successful application for eligibility based free school meals has been made.
