

School PE Kit

We have recently noticed that an increasing number of pupils are coming to the office to borrow PE Kit. Please could parents be mindful of the need to send their child to school with the necessary PE Kit. Kit can be kept in school ready for when it is needed and taken home to be washed as and when necessary. If pupils ask to borrow kit on multiple occasions we will send a letter home to inform parents.

We do have a small supply of spare kit which should only need to be used on occasions where PE kit is not provided for a valid reason. This supply is becoming more limited due to pupils not returning the kit after borrowing it. We will therefore be putting a new system in place whereby school property will be labelled and parents will be notified in writing if kit is not returned.

As you will appreciate, PE is an important part of the school curriculum and the education of your child. It is therefore essential that your child is suitably equipped and able to participate. If you have any queries or concerns about providing the kit required, then please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

As a reminder the kit required is **Black Shorts, White T-Shirt, Trainers or Pumps.**
