Was your child born between

1st September 2013 and 31st August 2014?

year (2018/19). You should apply for a school place NOW

or your child may lose out on a place at your
preferred school. Closing date for applications is:

Please note: even if your child attends the School
Nursery you still have to apply to the main school for a
Reception place through the Local Authority.
