Read all sorts of different books and make it enjoyable. Read to your child as well as asking them to read to you.

Hazel class are learning about the weather. They have already done some super work.

At home your child could:

Keep a diary about the weather. Record the changes in a day and over a week.	Find out about the weather in another country. Write about what it might be like to live there.	Make a list of all the things you can do on a <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hot day</li><li>• Cold day</li><li>• Windy day</li><li>• Foggy day</li><li>• Snowy day</li></ul>
Look out of the window and write down everything you can see. Then write a poem called "Through my window I can see...."	Write My Daily News about what you have been doing.	How does the weather affect what you eat? Write a menu for a hot day and a menu for a cold day.

Paint a picture of every kind of weather.	Make a shadow puppet.	Look at the shadows in the garden in the morning. Check them at lunch time and tea time. How have they changed? Take photos or draw pictures to keep a record.
Make a windsock and put it in the garden.	Ask your grown-ups what their favourite/worst weather is. Draw a chart to show everyone's choices.	Draw your family tree. Write about the people in your family.
