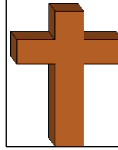

Please do not use ClassDojo for this purpose.

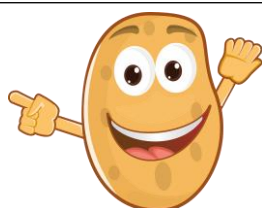
UNIFORM
